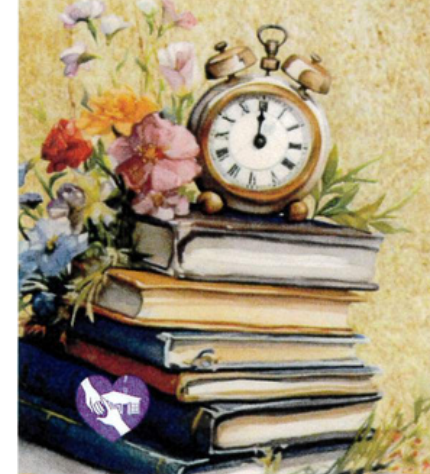

Each year, on the second-to-last Sunday of October, Catholics around the world unite in celebration of World Mission Sunday—a day of prayer, reflection, and financial support for the Church’s missionary work in 1,124 mission territories. World Mission Sunday is not just the occasion of another second collection. It is the one Sunday when the entire Catholic Church—every parish, in every country—comes together to pray for and support the missionary efforts of the Church through The Society for the Propagation of the Faith, one of the four Pontifical Mission Societies.

This year’s theme, chosen by Pope Francis, is inspired by the Jubilee of Hope: “Missionaries of Hope Among the Peoples.” Our second collection this Sunday, October 19th will be to support this effort.

Es el único domingo en el que toda la Iglesia católica —cada parroquia, en cada país— se reúne para orar y apoyar la labor misionera de la Iglesia a través de la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe, una de las cuatro Obras Misionales Pontificias.

El tema de este año, elegido por el Papa Francisco, está inspirado en el Jubileo de la Esperanza: “Misioneros de la Esperanza entre los Pueblos”. Nuestra segunda colecta, este domingo 19 de octubre, será para apoyar esta iniciativa.

This Week’s Reflection

You and I are the Church because of our baptism.
As our Holy Father has reminded us, we have a baptismal responsibility to participate in the worldwide missionary task of the Church. Half the people of the world have yet to hear of Jesus’ message of salvation. We have not been called to pack up and preach the Word in foreign lands. But we can participate in the missionary task.
We can pray daily for our brothers and sisters who have chosen to minister the Word around the world. Their task is often difficult; we can pray that they do not lose heart as they minister. We can also offer them financial assistance in their task. Many of the people they serve earn less than a dollar a day. These are our brothers and sisters in need - and we can help them.
The Scriptures today speak of perseverance - perseverance in the task of preaching the Word and perseverance in praying.
The image of Moses interceding for God’s people offers us some instruction about our community prayer. As Moses became weak and weary, Aaron and Hur held up his hands. Sometimes we come to community prayer weak and weary. The voices of our sisters help us to persevere in praying.
Listening to God’s word each day inspires us as we continue our baptismal commission to live and preach the Good News.
And what about our prayers of intercession? Do we believe that God cares enough to listen to us? Do we believe that God answers our prayers, even if it’s not always the answer we’re expecting? Or do we tend to lose heart after praying a few times?
Jesus’ question to his disciples in today’s Gospel is a question put to us: When I return, will I find you faithful, persevering? Or will I find that you have abandoned your trust in my love?
How we choose to live each day is the only answer we can give. May we pray each day for those who preach the Gospel throughout the world. And may we persevere each day, trusting in God’s love for us, and not losing heart.

Reflexión de esta semana

Tú y yo somos la Iglesia por nuestro bautismo.

Como nos ha recordado nuestro Santo Padre, tenemos la responsabilidad bautismal de participar en la tarea misionera mundial de la Iglesia. La mitad de la población mundial aún no ha escuchado el mensaje de salvación de Jesús. No hemos sido llamados a empacar y predicar la Palabra en tierras extranjeras. Pero podemos participar en la tarea misionera.

Podemos orar diariamente por nuestros hermanos y hermanas que han elegido ministrar la Palabra en todo el mundo. Su tarea suele ser difícil; podemos orar para que no desfallezcan en su ministerio. También podemos ofrecerles ayuda financiera en su tarea. Muchas de las personas a las que sirven ganan menos de un dólar al día. Estos son nuestros hermanos y hermanas necesitados, y podemos ayudarlos.

Las Escrituras de hoy hablan de perseverancia: perseverancia en la tarea de predicar la Palabra y perseverancia en la oración.

La imagen de Moisés intercediendo por el pueblo de Dios nos ofrece algunas instrucciones sobre nuestra oración comunitaria. Cuando Moisés se debilitó y se cansó, Aarón y Hur le levantaron las manos. A veces llegamos a la oración comunitaria débiles y cansadas. Las voces de nuestras hermanas nos ayudan a perseverar en la oración.

Escuchar la palabra de Dios cada día nos inspira a continuar con nuestra comisión bautismal de vivir y predicar la Buena Nueva.

¿Y qué hay de nuestras oraciones de intercesión? ¿Creemos que Dios se preocupa lo suficiente como para escucharnos? ¿Creemos que Dios responde a nuestras oraciones, aunque no siempre sea la respuesta que esperamos? ¿O tendemos a desanimarnos después de orar varias veces?

La pregunta de Jesús a sus discípulos en el Evangelio de hoy es una pregunta dirigida a nosotros: Cuando regrese, ¿los encontraré fieles y perseverantes? ¿O descubriré que han abandonado su confianza en mi amor?

La forma en que elegimos vivir cada día es la única respuesta que podemos dar. Oremos cada día por quienes predicán el Evangelio en todo el mundo. Y perseveremos cada día, confiando en el amor de Dios por nosotros y sin desanimarnos.
