Fr. Andrew M. Jaspers

Fr. Jaspers is an educator and researcher in the philosophy of nature and sustainability. He completed eight graduate courses in theology at Fordham University in New York in 2005 and in 2009 he received his Masters of Divinity/Bachelors' of Sacred Theology. Since 2021, he has been a full-time chaplain at North Memorial Health in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul & Minneapolis. Within the archdiocese he was appointed Parochial Vicar at several parishes and held teaching positions at major higher learning institutions around the United States. He is the author of numerous articles and book contributions.

Fr. Jaspers explains that, "Giving to the missions has been a mainstay of Catholic parish life for many generations" and believes this is what "...makes Cross Catholic Outreach's efforts more necessary and unique" in order to continue to support the Church in foreign countries which are experiencing unprecedented growth and need urgent support.

FEATURED THIS MONTH

Reflection on the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 15, 2025 (Holy Day of Obligation)

The Solemnity of the Assumption celebrates the Blessed Mother's entrance into heavenly glory. The Catechism explains that Mary "was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of his Body" (CCC, 974).

Mary's Assumption into heaven reminds us that life on earth is a pilgrimage to our ultimate destination. We prepare in hope for our own passage into eternal life by the choices we make today. When we choose to love and follow God in our daily lives, we strengthen our relationship with Him, and this relationship is the true meaning of heaven: "To live in heaven is 'to be with Christ'" (CCC, 1025).

We can see how, throughout her life, the Blessed Mother continually chose to go deeper into her relationship with God. She modeled how to value and respect His precious gift of human life, from the moment of conception to its natural end. In the Annunciation, through her "yes," Mary witnessed to the undeniable humanity of pre-born children as she conceived and carried the Christ child in her womb. After the Annunciation, having learned that her cousin Elizabeth was with child, she went in haste to her aid.

Our Blessed Mother shows us how the way we live today can prepare us, in hope, to also enter into heavenly glory at the end of our lives. Are we open to God's precious gift of new life? How do we support pregnant mothers and parents? Do we prioritize showing our love to those who are ill or aging? Do we care for them in a way that respects God's gift of life?

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

We ended the week with Adoration, during which the children sang songs they had learned throughout the week. Afterward, we gathered in the social hall for ice cream, Kahoot, and a slideshow.

19 Domingo Ordinario Reflexión de Esta Semana Jesús ha deseado desde la eternidad encontrarse con nosotros en esta cena sagrada. Nos invita a sentarnos con él y escucharlo mientras nos habla del amor de nuestro Padre por nosotros y lo que desea para nosotros. También nos dirá cómo podemos corresponder a su amoroso cuidado. Nuestro Padre se complace en darnos el reino. Nos invita a confiar en su promesa, a hacer del único deseo de nuestro corazón el tesoro que se nos ha prometido y dado. La señal de nuestra esperanza segura será nuestra disposición a estar preparados cada día: preparados para buscar la voluntad de nuestro Padre para nosotros cada día y cumplirla con amor; preparados para vivir con Jesús a nuestro lado cada día, hablando con él sobre nuestra jornada y escuchándolo mientras nos habla, a menudo a través de las personas y los acontecimientos de nuestro día; preparados para cuidar con cariño a cada persona que encontremos hoy. Jesús nos dice: se esperará mucho de quien mucho se le confía. Tú y yo hemos recibido mucho de nuestro Dios. Seamos dignos de la confianza que nuestro Dios deposita en nosotros como sus hijos amados. 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time This Week’s Reflection Jesus has desired from all eternity to meet us here at this sacred meal. He invites us to sit down with him and listen as he tells us about our Father’s love for us and what our Father desires for us. He will also tell us how we can respond to our Father’s loving care for us. Jesus offers us the example of Abraham and Sarah, our ancestors in the faith, in today’s reading from the Letter to the Hebrews. He tells us that we have faith when we accept our God’s word as the truth, confident that what God says will become a reality. Both Abraham and Sarah did just that: They left their homeland for a new land that God promised. They accepted God’s word that they would have a child even though they were old. They were willing to sacrifice their son Isaac who was the only evidence they had of God’s promise of many descendants. And God gave Isaac back to them as a sign of the truth of God’s word to them and as a witness to their confident hope. Jesus offers their example to us as a reminder. He tells us not to be afraid. Our Father is pleased to give us the kingdom. He invites us to place our trust in our Father’s promise, to make our heart’s only desire the treasure we have been promised and given. The sign of our confident hope will be our willingness to be prepared each day: prepared to seek our Father’s will for us each day and do it lovingly; prepared to live with Jesus at our side each day, talking with him about our day and listening as he talks to us, often through the people and events of our day; prepared to care gently for each person we will meet today. Jesus tells us: much will be expected of the person entrusted with much. You and I have been given much by our God. Let us be worthy of the trust our God puts in us as his beloved children. Let us take what Jesus tells us at this meal and live it out today – and every day. He is here to strengthen us to do just that - for he gives us his Body to eat and his Blood to drink. www.oblates.org
