Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (January 25, 2026)

This week's reflection

Today's reading from Isaiah announces once again that Jesus' coming among us has brought light to the darkness and gloom of our world. Jesus has smashed the yoke of sin; he brings us joy and reason for great rejoicing. You and I have been brought into the Light through our baptism, and we are grateful for this gift.

We look around us, and it's easy to see the gloom and darkness that cover so many peoples' lives. Since our baptism gives us a share in Jesus' mission to bring Light to the world, it's important that His Light be with us as we go about our daily living. The way we reach out to the people we live with and work with offers us an opportunity to share His Light. Our caring, our honesty, our compassion, our willingness to forgive – each can bring Light into the darkness which envelops many of our brothers and sisters.

Like Andrew and Peter, James and John, Jesus calls us to follow him into our world. We need to be clear about our mission as followers. We are called to share the Light of Christ, not our own light. If we are sharing the only true light – Jesus, then there can be no factions, no special groups. We are called to be one in the Body of Christ; otherwise, we risk rendering the cross of Christ void of its meaning, as we heard St. Paul tell us.

Today we are invited to spend some time renewing our commitment to live in the Light of Christ. In prayer and Eucharist, we can gain some new insights into how we can do this more completely.

And now the Lord will come to nourish us for our continuing journey with him.

May we let Jesus live in us more and more each day and may His Light shine through us in all we do.

May God be praised in our efforts today!

Dear Sisters and Brothers of St. Francis De Sales Parish,

Adult Faith Formation begins this year again meeting every 2nd and 4th Wednesday of every month. We are excited to bring forth our Faith, Our Bible study, Our teachings and Our spirituality to you.

As we resume classes, we intend to continue our tradition of education and faith building among our parishioners with a welcome to any adults interested in growing in their faith and relationship with Christ, Mary His Mother and saints.

This year we are going to finish our coverage of church teaching by delving into the councils of the church. We assure you that if you are interested in truth, history and learning, you will find these classes interesting, entertaining and highly informative.

One of the early Church Fathers, St. Jerome said " Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ". He was the one responsible for translating the Bible into the Latin Vulgate. He views Scripture study as fundamental to Christian life and faith. Similarly, knowledge of Church teachings is essential to us as well. How many of us are equipped enough to defend our faith in today's world of secularism, totalitarianism and forces of false teaching. In living our call to evangelization are we able to explain the church's stand on various issues and challenges of the world.

For some of us it may be that we ourselves are questioning the validity of Church teaching. Come talk to us about your doubts and questions.

Once we cover the councils, we are going to address true worship based on Biblical teaching and church traditions.
