22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

This Week’s Reflection

Today’s Scripture readings encourage us to ask ourselves: am I humble, a virtue that finds favor with God?

As we know, St. Francis de Sales considered humility the acceptance of who I am in the eyes of God. I imagine none of us has to be reminded that we are sinners. We’re often all too conscious of that fact.

We don’t always remember that Jesus came to earth to tell us sinners that our Father loves us. Jesus chose to die on the cross to save us from our sins and he rose to share his new life with us. Through our baptism, Jesus has made us his brothers and sisters – adopted children of his Father. We are now “graced sinners,” loved by our God. When I am thankful that I am a “graced sinner” in the eyes of God, then I am practicing true humility.

All that we are and all that we have is gift -- a gift of God’s love for us. When we accept that fact, then we can follow the advice Sirach offered us: “Conduct your affairs with humility.” That will mean recognizing our own dignity as we go about our day. It will also help us to realize that the same dignity is God’s gift to every person we meet.

God is choosing to live and work in me; God is also choosing to live and work in you. As I respect and honor God’s presence in me, so I must try to respect and honor God’s presence in you. This is the kind of humility we are asked to live today.

Remembering that I am a sinner will keep me aware of my limitations; remembering that I am graced will help me to trust in God’s providence for me. Remembering that I am a sinner will keep me from judging others; remembering that I am graced will move me to reach out to others who are suffering. Remembering that I am a sinner will lead me to call on God’s mercy frequently; remembering that I am graced will lead me to be thankful often during the day.

Let us be humble before the Lord and with one another today. Sirach assures us that we will find favor with God.

Reflexión de esta semana

Las lecturas bíblicas de hoy nos animan a preguntarnos: ¿Soy humilde, una virtud que agrada a Dios?

Como sabemos, San Francisco de Sales consideraba la humildad la aceptación de quien soy a los ojos de Dios. Imagino que a ninguno de nosotros hace falta que nos recuerden que somos pecadores. A menudo somos muy conscientes de ello.

No siempre recordamos que Jesús vino a la tierra para decirnos, pecadores, que nuestro Padre nos ama. Jesús eligió morir en la cruz para salvarnos de nuestros pecados y resucitó para compartir su nueva vida con nosotros. A través de nuestro bautismo, Jesús nos ha hecho sus hermanos y hermanas, hijos adoptivos de su Padre. Ahora somos "pecadores agraciados", amados por nuestro Dios. Cuando agradezco ser un "pecador agraciado" a los ojos de Dios, entonces estoy practicando la verdadera humildad.

Todo lo que somos y todo lo que tenemos es un regalo: un regalo del amor de Dios por nosotros. Cuando aceptamos esta realidad, podemos seguir el consejo del Sirácida: «Conduce tus asuntos con humildad». Esto implica reconocer nuestra propia dignidad en nuestro día a día. También nos ayudará a comprender que esa misma dignidad es un don de Dios para cada persona que conocemos.

Dios elige vivir y obrar en mí; Dios también elige vivir y obrar en ti. Así como respeto y honro la presencia de Dios en mí, debo tratar de respetar y honrar la presencia de Dios en ti. Esta es la clase de humildad que se nos pide vivir hoy.

Recordar que soy pecador me ayudará a ser consciente de mis limitaciones; recordar que soy agraciado me ayudará a confiar en la providencia de Dios para mí. Recordar que soy pecador me impedirá juzgar a los demás; recordar que soy agraciado me impulsará a acercarme a quienes sufren. Recordar que soy pecador me llevará a invocar la misericordia de Dios con frecuencia; recordar que soy agraciado me llevará a ser agradecido con frecuencia durante el día.

Seamos humildes ante el Señor y unos con otros hoy. El Eclesiástico nos asegura que hallaremos favor ante Dios.

"practical paths to holiness"

"Holiness: All Work? No Way!"



"All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy."

Not only might it make Jack dull: it might cripple his attempts to be happy, healthy, and even holy.

Make no mistake. Growing in holiness - making real in our own lives the love of the God in whose image and likeness we are created - is serious business. It requires hard work; it requires discipline; it requires self-examination; it requires commitment.

As Francis de Sales would say, it requires devotion.

But Salesian spirituality also recognizes the value of relaxation, of taking 'time out,' of 'catching your breath,' of making time for play. In fact, relaxation is not only permissible: it is necessary!

Francis de Sales claims: "It is actually a defect to be so strict, austere and unsociable that one neither permits oneself nor others any recreation time."

The Introduction to the Devout Life (1609) contains ample evidence of the Gentleman Saint's appreciation of the important role that recreation plays in the pursuit of a fully human, God-centered life. He says: "From time to time we must recreate in

mind and body."

He continues: "To take the air, to go for a walk, to enjoy a friendly chat, to play music, or sing or hunt...are such honest diversions that the only thing needed to utilize them well is simple prudence, which gives to all things their rank, time, place and measure."

To be balanced, we need to know our limitations. St. Jane once wrote in the context of a letter to a member of her community: "I must run, for I have little leisure and my arm and hand are starting to tire and hurt, even though I've just begun to write. I'm not able to do as much as I used to."

In his book Touching the Ordinary, Robert Wicks identifies practices that can help us establish and maintain a balanced life: get enough sleep; eat right; practice leisure; pace yourself. Learn to laugh; focus on values; practice self-appreciation; be involved, but not too involved; have a support group; escape on occasion; be spontaneous; avoid negativity. Establish good friendships; practice intimacy.

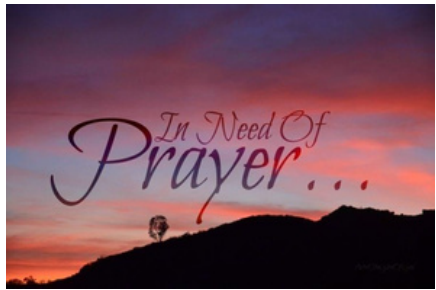
Of course, there are also the spiritual practices - pray; participate in the life of the Church; celebrate the sacraments; read Scripture and other material that

nourishes the soul.

Our Lord Jesus Christ spent virtually his entire public ministry meeting the needs of others: healing, teaching, feeding, challenging, forgiving: in short, working. But the Gospels that document Christ's work ethic also clearly document those times when he withdrew from his activities to rest, to renew, to enjoy another's hospitality, to spend time with friends, all helpful in rededicating himself to doing the Will of God.

There are plenty of ways to achieve balance between work and play, livelihood and leisure, pay and play. Consider them in a personal, prayerful manner. Choose those consistent with the state and stage of life in which you find yourself at this time: what works for others may not work for you. Realize that as your life changes, so too may your means for achieving this happy, healthy and holy balance.

As you travel along the highway of life, take your foot off the gas now and then. Ride with the windows down. Pull over on occasion. Visit the rest stop. Check out the scenic overlooks. Balancing work and play will not only help you to reach your destination in one piece, but it may enable you to truly enjoy the trip!
