## Rev. Eloy Romero-Rojas



El Padre Romero-Rojas nació en Caracas, Venezuela, y fue ordenado sacerdote el 1º de marzo de 2000, en la Diócesis Militar de Venezuela. Reside en Fort Lee, Nueva Jersey.

El Padre Romero-Rojas estudió en la Universidad Católica de Santa Rosa de Lima en Caracas, Venezuela, por su Licenciatura en Filosofía de 1991 a 1993; sirvió en el Seminario Militar de Bogotá, Colombia, de 1995 a 1999. Obtuvo títulos en teología y asuntos internacionales de la Pontificia Universidad Xaveriana de Bogotá en 2017. El Padre Romero-Rojas obtuvo su Maestría en Bioética y Derecho de la Universidad de Barcelona y una Maestría en Cuidados Paliativos de la Pontificia Universidad de Salamanca. Antes de venir a los Estados Unidos, el padre Romero-Rojas fue capellán militar de la Fuerza Armada de Venezuela.

Durante los últimos veinte años, el padre Rojas ha viajado y predicado en parroquias de todo Estados Unidos recaudando fondos y generando conciencia entre los católicos estadounidenses sobre la necesidad de proteger a las poblaciones oprimidas y abandonadas del mundo en desarrollo. En 2016, el papa Francisco lo designó Misionero de la Misericordia.

Él aporta sus experimentadas habilidades de predicación bilingüe a Cross Catholic Outreach, así como su dedicación a los corderos más preciosos de Dios: ¡los pobres!

## Rev. Eloy Romero-Rojas



Fr. Romero-Rojas was born in Caracas, Venezuela, and ordained to the priesthood on March 17, 2000, in the Military Diocese of Venezuela. He resides in Fort Lee, New Jersey.

Fr. Romero-Rojas went to the Catholic University of Saint Rose of Lima in Caracas, Venezuela for his Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy from 1991 to 1993; served in the Military Seminary of Bogota, Colombia from 1995 to 1999. He obtained degrees in theology and international affairs from the Pontifical University Xaveriana in Bogota in 2017. Fr. Romero-Rojas earned his Masters's Degree in Bioethics and Law from the University of Barcelona and a Masters's Degree in Palliative Care from The Pontifical University of Salamanca. Before coming to the United States, Fr. Romero-Rojas was a military chaplain for the Venezuelan Air Force.

For the last twenty years, Fr. Rojas has been traveling and preaching in parishes across the United States raising funds and generating awareness among U.S. Catholics for the downtrodden and the neglected populations in the developing world. In 2016 he was commissioned as a Missionary of Mercy by Pope Francis.

He brings his experienced bilingual preaching skills to Cross Catholic Outreach, as well as his dedication to God's most precious lambs - the poor!

In today's Gospel, Jesus urges us to remain faithful to Him and  
to live in the "spirit that gives life." St. Francis de Sales notes:

Our Savior came to recreate humanity. When we live in the  
Spirit of Jesus, we transcend our ordinary life in order to live a  
loftier life. We are so filled with divine love that we are like the  
stars whose light is totally absorbed in the sunlight. God lives in  
us, and our only desire is to unite our will to God's Will.

To progress in living in the Spirit of Jesus, we must first of all  
accept ourselves as being less than perfect. Don't lose heart, be  
patient, wait while joyously carrying out your daily activities. Do  
everything you are taught in a spirit of gentleness and fidelity.  
Develop a spirit of compassion. After we have planted and  
watered, we must realize that it is for God to give the increase  
to the trees that are our good inclinations and habits. For this  
reason, we must wait to obtain the fruits of our desires and  
labors from divine Providence.

If we are not progressing, as we desire, let us not be disturbed.  
In living a holy life our whole life is destined to be a practical  
testing. Let us remain at peace so that calmness always reigns in  
our hearts. It is up to us to cultivate our souls well, and we must  
faithfully attend to them. But as for a plentiful harvest, let us  
leave the care of that to our Lord. The laborer will never be  
blamed for not having a fine harvest unless he or she did not  
carefully till and sow his or her field. Our unwavering  
dependence on God assures us that we are solidly planted where  
God wants us to be.

I have no doubt that our Savior is holding you by the hand. If  
you stumble, it is only to let you know that if you let go of His  
hand you would fall rather than stumble. For those of us who  
love and hope in God, our weakness is not as great as God's  
mercy.

Permanezcamos en paz para que la calma reine siempre en nuestro corazón. De nosotros depende cultivar bien nuestra alma y debemos ocuparnos fielmente de ella. Pero en cuanto a la cosecha abundante, dejémosla en manos de nuestro Señor. Nunca se culpará al trabajador por no tener una buena cosecha, a menos que no haya cultivado y sembrado cuidadosamente su campo. Nuestra inquebrantable dependencia de Dios nos asegura que estamos sólidamente plantados donde Dios quiere que estemos.

No tengo ninguna duda de que nuestro Salvador te lleva de la mano. Si tropiezas, es solo para hacerte saber que si te sueltas de su mano, caerás en lugar de tropezar. Para los que amamos a Dios y esperamos en él, nuestra debilidad no es tan grande como la misericordia de Dios.




